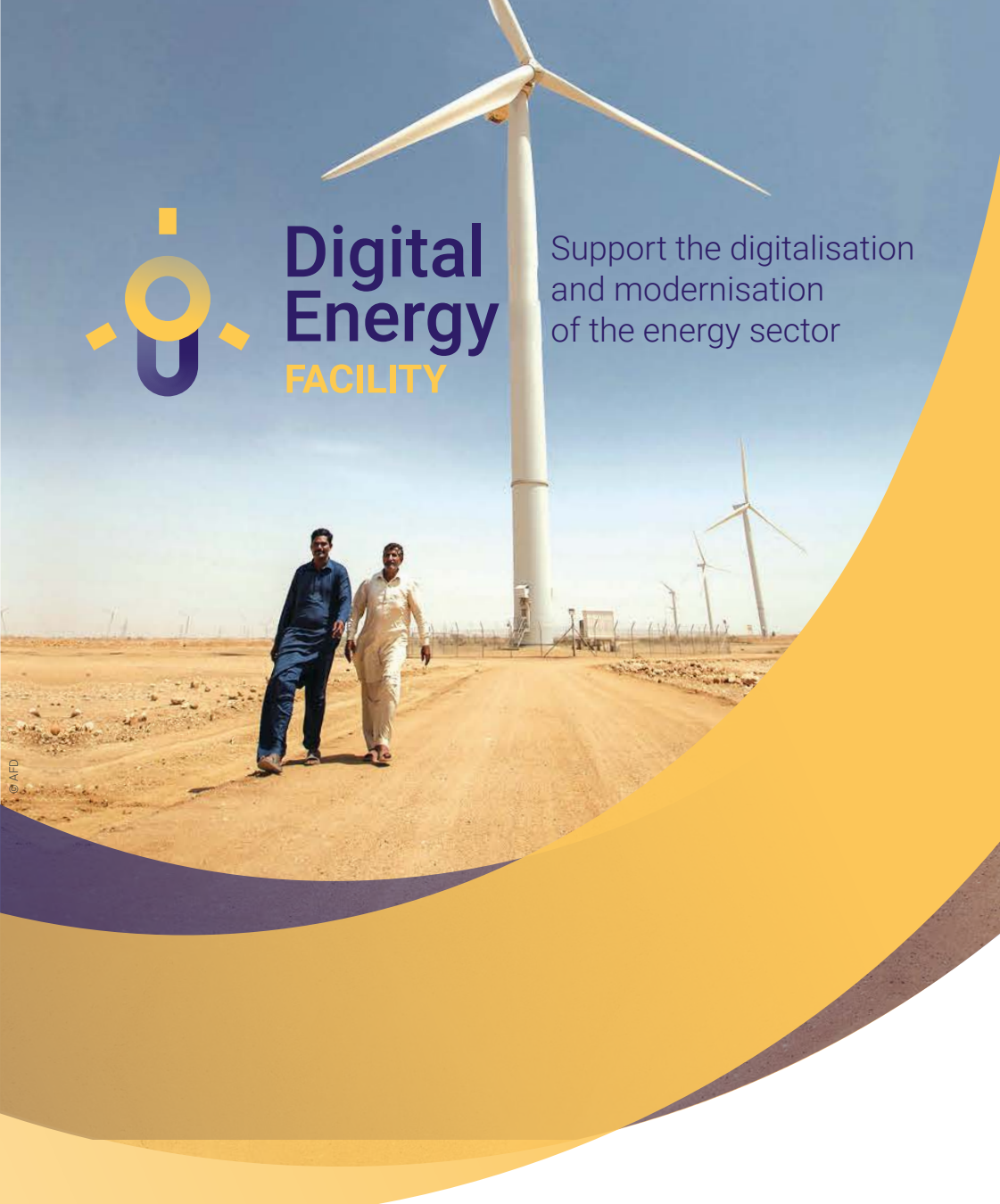

WHAT IS DEF?

The **Digital Energy Facility (DEF)** is a programme funded by the European Union and implemented by Agence Française de Développement (AFD).

Thanks to the financing of **digital innovation projects and products**, the facility aims to:

-  Support the integration of renewable energy sources into the grid.
-  Increase energy access.
-  Improve the performance of power utilities and reduce technical and commercial losses.



Why do we need it?

The energy sector is facing key changes which have disrupted the structure of the network:



The facility has **4 components** and levers of action

1 Digitalisation of utilities **€6,7M**

- Technical assistance projects to support the digitalisation of utilities such as performance diagnosis, digitalisation roadmap. 10 projects targeted. (€5,7M).
- Capacity building projects such as webinars, workshops (€1M).

→ **Targets: public utilities / national energy companies.**

2 Fostering innovation **€7,2M**

€1,2M for the calls' organisation
€6M for the support to winners

- Organisation of an annual call for projects aiming at promoting partnerships between power utilities and innovative private companies.
 - Technical and financial support for the selected projects.
- **Targets: utilities and startups developing innovative digital solutions for the energy sector.**

3 Creation of a Digital Energy Community **€1,8M**

- Online platform providing resources (data gathering and analysis, studies) and giving networking opportunities (online workshops, B2B events, etc.).
- A website, social networks, newsletter.

→ **Targets: all actors of the energy sector.**

4 Seed financing for innovative energy companies **€4,8M (debt)**

- Seed financing (between 300k€ and 400k€) for start-ups to experiment and scale up innovative solutions for access to energy.

→ **Targets: at least 10 startups.**

HOW IS DEF SUPPORTING ENERGY ACTORS?

DEF offers a variety of complementary instruments to support energy actors in their digitalisation process and eventually build partnerships between utilities and private sector.

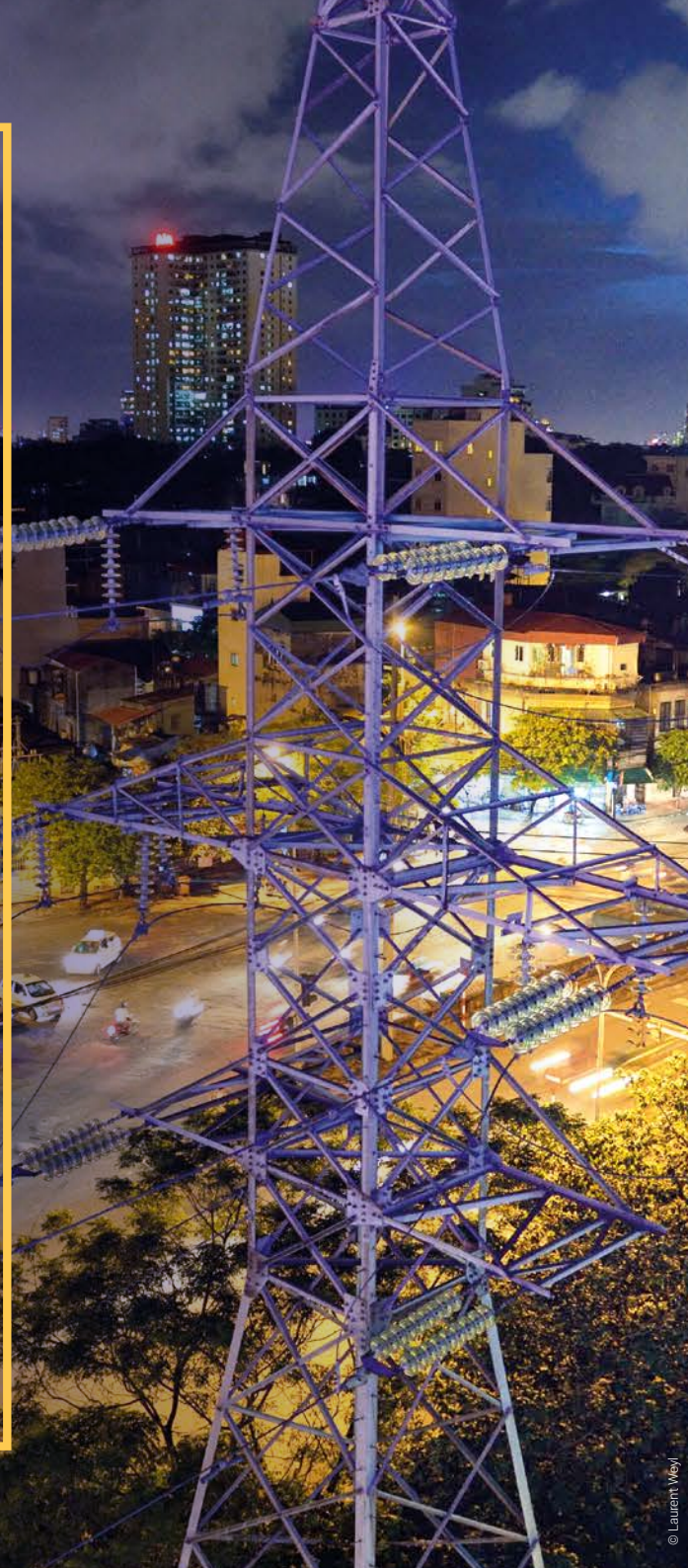
