The Digital Energy Facility (DEF)

is a programme funded by the European Union and implemented by Agence Française de Développement (AFD).

Digitalisation of utilities **€6,7M**

- Technical assistance projects to support the digitalisation of utilities such as performance diagnosis, digitalisation roadmap. 10 projects targeted. (€5,7M).
- Capacity building projects such as webinars, workshops (€1M).
- \rightarrow Targets: public utilities / national energy companies.

Fostering innovation **€7,2M**

- Organisation of an annual call for projects aiming at promoting partnerships between power utilities and innovative private companies.
- Technical and financial support for the selected projects.
- → Targets: utilities and startups developing innovative digital solutions for the energy sector.

Creation of a Digital Energy Community **€1,8M**

- Online platform providing resources (data gathering and analysis, studies) and giving networking opportunities (online workshops, B2B events, etc.).
- A website, social networks, newsletter.
- \rightarrow Targets: all actors of the energy sector.

Seed financing for innovative energy companies €4,8M (debt)


- Seed financing (between 300k€ and 400k€) for start-ups to experiment and scale up innovative solutions for access to energy.
- \rightarrow Targets: at least 10 startups.
