

# 12 partner countries in phase 2

**AdaptAction supports countries that are particularly exposed to the impacts of climate change (droughts, floods, hurricanes, heat waves...). Phase 2 is mainly focused on Africa, where these vulnerabilities are exacerbated.**

Additional partner countries in the Mediterranean basin are currently under consideration with funding from the European Union (DG Near), in partnership with UNCDF-LoCAL. The region has been identified by the IPCC as an adaptation hotspot.

# Strengthening populations' and ecosystems' resilience

More than 3 billion people live in contexts that are highly vulnerable to climate change (IPCC, 2022). Yet, adapting to the impacts of climate change remains a complex process: multiple sectors as well as a wide range of social, economic, cultural and political factors interact together. Reconciling the different timeframes for action (immediate needs vs long-term goals) can also be challenging.

## A threefold strategy: understanding, planning, investing


AdaptAction strives  
to better understand adaptation processes,  
but also to support the translation  
of scientific knowledge into governance  
mechanisms, public policies  
and adaptation-sensitive investments.

### From phase 1

During AdaptAction's first phase (2017-2022), which had €30M budget, more than 500 experts were mobilised to deliver 75 projects in 15 partner countries and regional organisations.

### to phase 2

AdaptAction's Phase 2 (2022-2025) was launched at COP 26 with €15M of additional funding.



### A LABORATORY FOR INNOVATIONS

Since 2017, AdaptAction has supported research projects, such as GAP-Track (IDDRI) and BRIO (Météo France), and explored innovative themes and approaches for the AFD Group, including ecosystem-based adaptation, gender, education, adaptive social protection and forecast-based financing.

### A MULTISECTORAL PROGRAMME

AdaptAction can cover the whole range of sectors impacted by climate change according to partner countries' priorities and needs: water resources, agriculture, disaster risk reduction, climate services, local planning, integrated coastal zone management, infrastructure.

The Sixth IPCC report also recommends a joint consideration of climate, biodiversity and society in order to increase the efficiency of adaptation measures and limit maladaptation risks. AdaptAction's phase 2 will pursue this threefold challenge, notably through ecosystem-based adaptation solutions.
