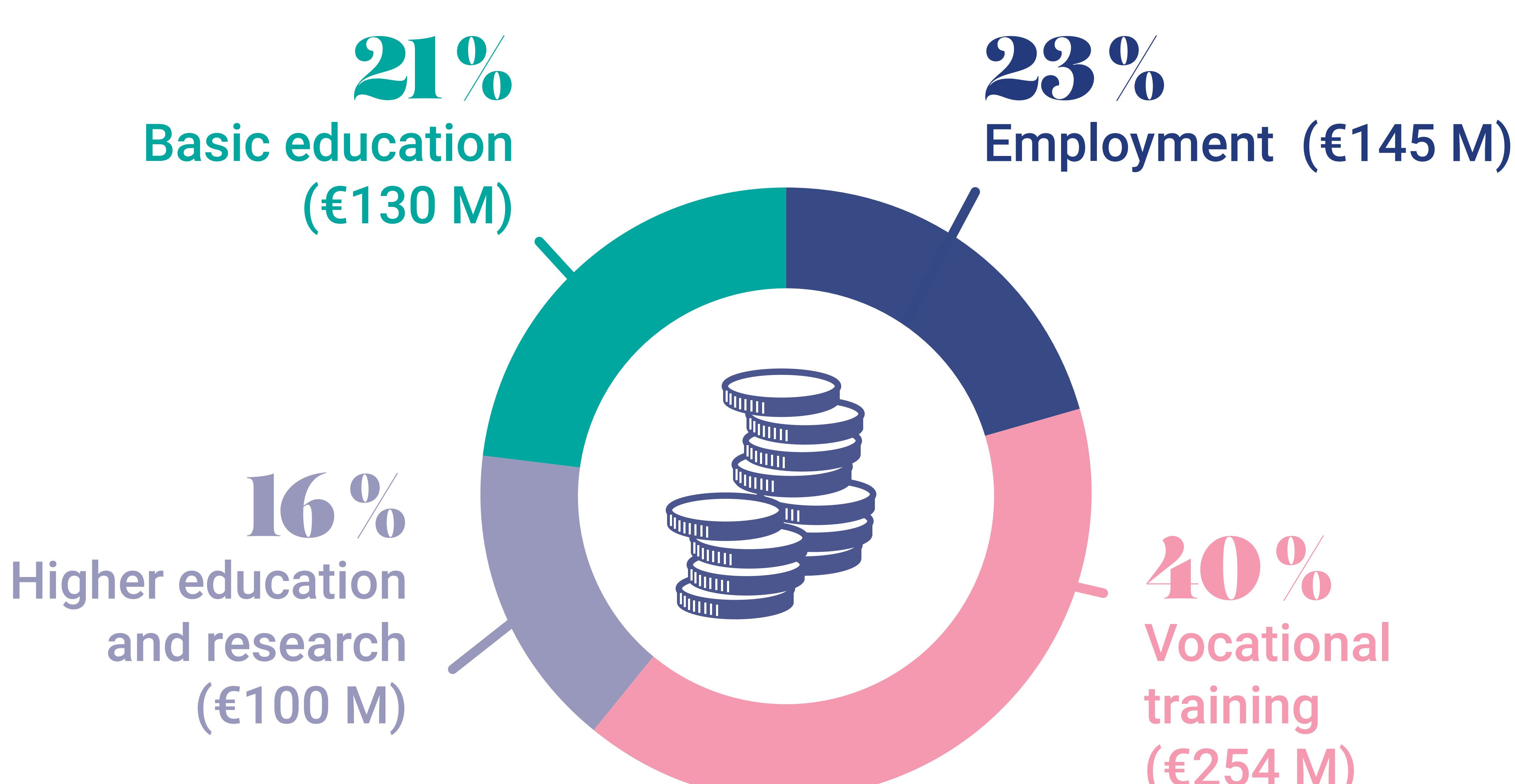

Promoting the creation of student housing, respecting ambitious standards in terms of social inclusion, environmental protection, energy efficiency and services



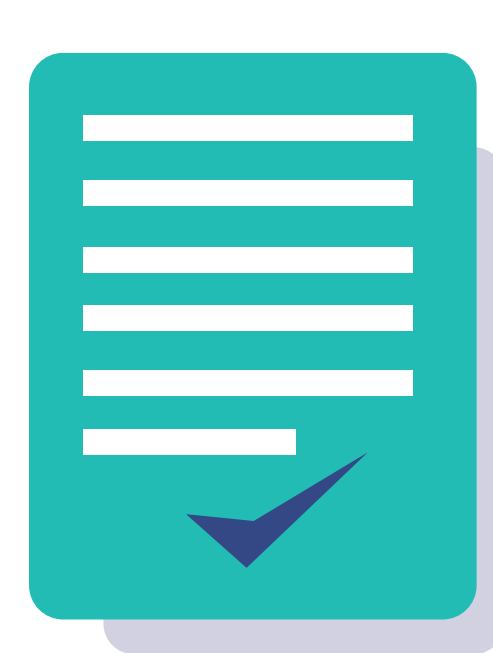
